Care of Multiples Course

Caring for a normal healthy baby is both rewarding and demanding, if however you are caring for more than one baby, it can be even more demanding!

In the UK the incidence of twins/triplets and higher order multiple births is high, partly due to the increased use of IVF treatment. As a result the demand for Maternity Nurses/Nannies, Childminders and Nursery staff capable of looking after twins/multiples is rising rapidly.

This 1 day course is designed for any professional child-carer who is working with, or aims to be working with, young babies, who wish to expand their knowledge/skills in caring for twins/multiples. All students will receive a certificate of attendance for their records, which will outline the topics covered on the course. This can be used at interviews and in professional portfolios.

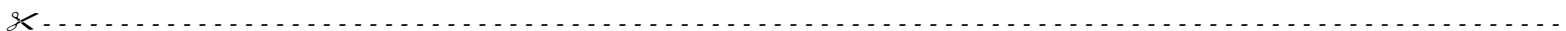
