Birth & Post-Natal Doula Course



This course is designed for any woman who wishes to become a Doula – this includes women who have not had their own children. A Doula can provide support to a woman post-natally or during birth and as such is a varied role. Students attending the course can elect to attend either the birth or post-natal elements of the course or both parts. The journey to become a Doula does not end with initial training– it is merely the beginning and an important aspect of a Doula's role is taking time to reflect on one's own practice.

The birth course lasts 2.5 days and the post– natal course lasts 1.5 days. Courses are held on consecutive days so students doing both parts will attend for 4 consecutive days.

Course numbers are limited to allow time for discussion and sharing of personal experiences for those who have had their own children. All students will be required to complete pre & post-course assessments and on successful completion will receive the course certificate.

Course content: (some items will be specific only to the birth or post-natal sections of the course)

- Role of the doula & journey to becoming a doula
- Writing a birth plan
- Commitment to natural childbirth/respecting a woman's choices
- Birth anatomy and physiology
- Optimal foetal positioning
- Interpreting signs – recognition of what is/what is not normal and when to call for medical help
- Bonding—physiology
- Needs of mother and baby in first 6 weeks
- Breast/bottle feeding
- Working within the NHS
- Relationship between doulas and midwives
- Researching and knowing local policies and support available for family
- Knowledge of relevant literature
- Communication/listening skills and diplomacy
- Birth debrief
- Reflection on own practice
- Negotiating contracts and finding work
- Support for the working doula

Course Fee: £225 (2.5 day birth doula course) £175 (1.5 day post-natal course) or £400 total if attending both birth and post-natal courses. (Students who opt to do both the birth and post-natal course will attend for 4 days total).

DOULA TRAINING COURSE BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The total cost of the course is £175 (post-natal including VAT) £225 (birth including VAT) or £400 (both birth and post-natal including VAT). In order to apply for a course, a non-refundable deposit of £50.00 is required along with the completed booking form. (As course places are limited and cannot always be guaranteed, it is recommended that you telephone MNT to determine course vacancies before applying in order to avoid disappointment.) If paying by credit card a 3.7% fee will be charged in addition to the course cost.
2. The balance of the Course fee is payable in full no later than 7 days before the start of the Course you have applied for. Once paid this is also non-refundable.
3. In the event of a student being unable to attend a course or complete a course no refunds will be available, however students may be offered a place on a later course at the discretion of MNT subject to availability.
